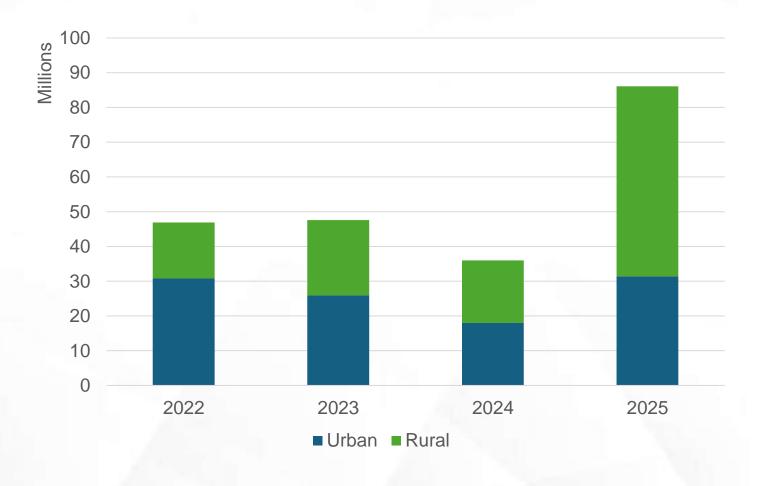

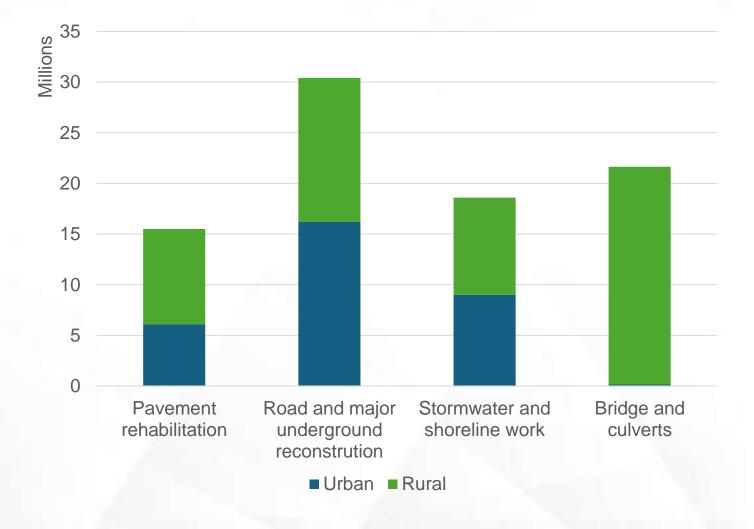


# Annual Capital Infrastructure Spending (Core Assets)

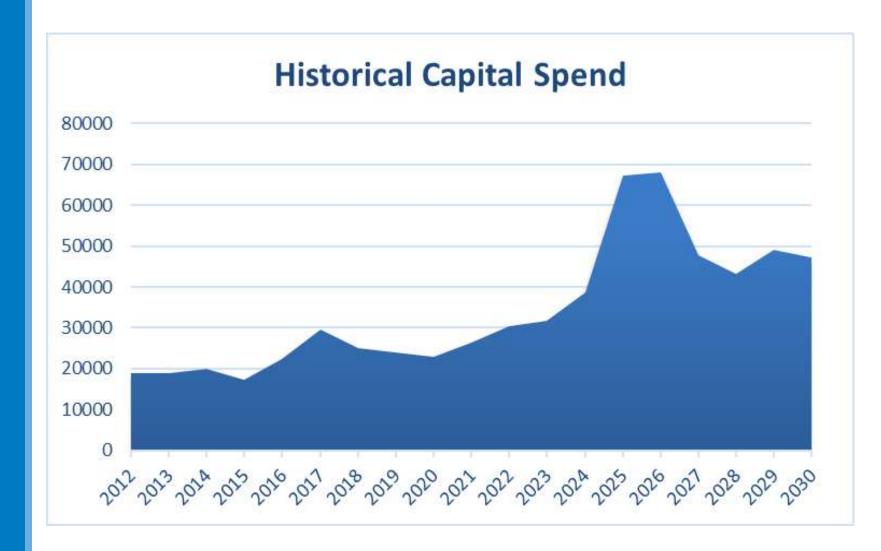

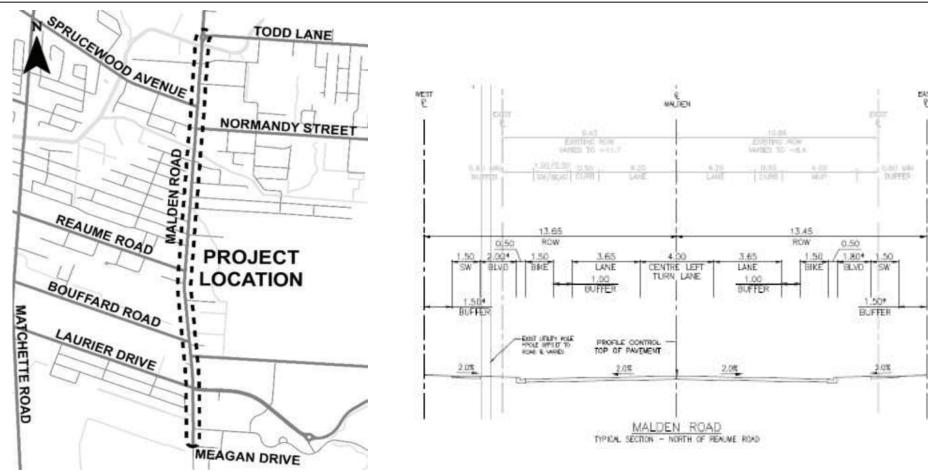

- 2025 10-year Capital Budget approved by Mayoral Decision MD 08-2025 (Feb 21, 2025):
  - Total of \$2.24B in spending
  - \$920.6M funding investments in service enhancements, growth, economic development and agencies, boards and commissions (increase of \$295.7M or 47.3% over 2024)
  - Additional \$321M in funding over the 2025-2033 timeframe compared to 2024 10-year plan



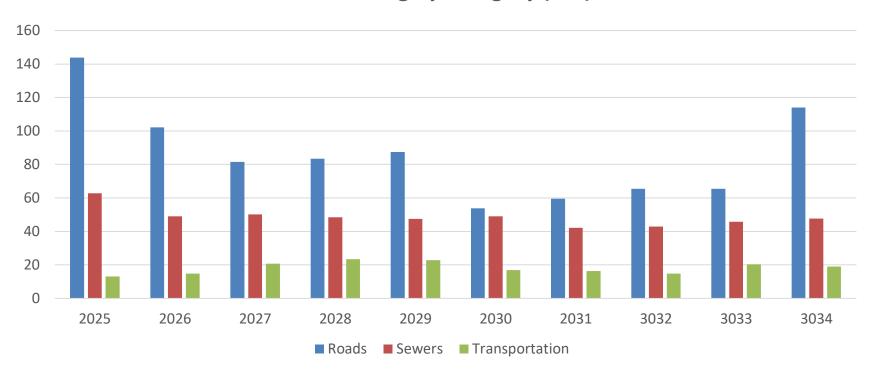

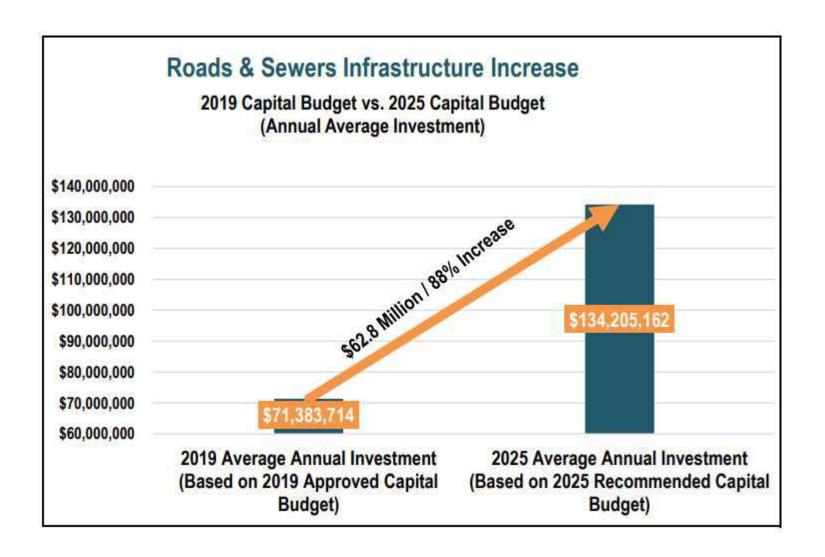


# **Capital Funding by Category**
