INDUSTRY UPDATE Building Department

Updates to Development Charges 2025

On November 1st, 2025, the Development Charges underwent a fee increase as approved by City Council during budget approval earlier this year.

In addition to this, the Provincial Government enacted Bill 17 with regard to non-rental residential projects and the ability to defer development charges. This process will include splitting building permit fees from Development Charges into two invoices. The first invoice, including all building permit fees, will be payable prior to permit issuance. The second invoice, including Development Charges, will be made available prior to occupancy. Occupancy will not be granted until both invoices have been paid.

Residential rental projects that would have previously qualified for frozen/deferred rates are still entitled to a specialized rate and payment plan without accruing interest.
